The Pie In The Sky is an architectural observation tower unlike any other - a spectacular parabolic outdoor lawn 200 feet in the air. An infinity edge allows viewers complete skyward observation, both day and night. An elegant double helix staircase defines the structure from a distance with subtle colorful ribbons. The tower is a destination for exercise and fitness, reflection, observation, and science. There are two associated structures; The Long House Pavilion acts as a laboratory for community gatherings. The Interpretive Center provides museum quality context and contrast to the tower. Visitors can breathe and open their minds.
