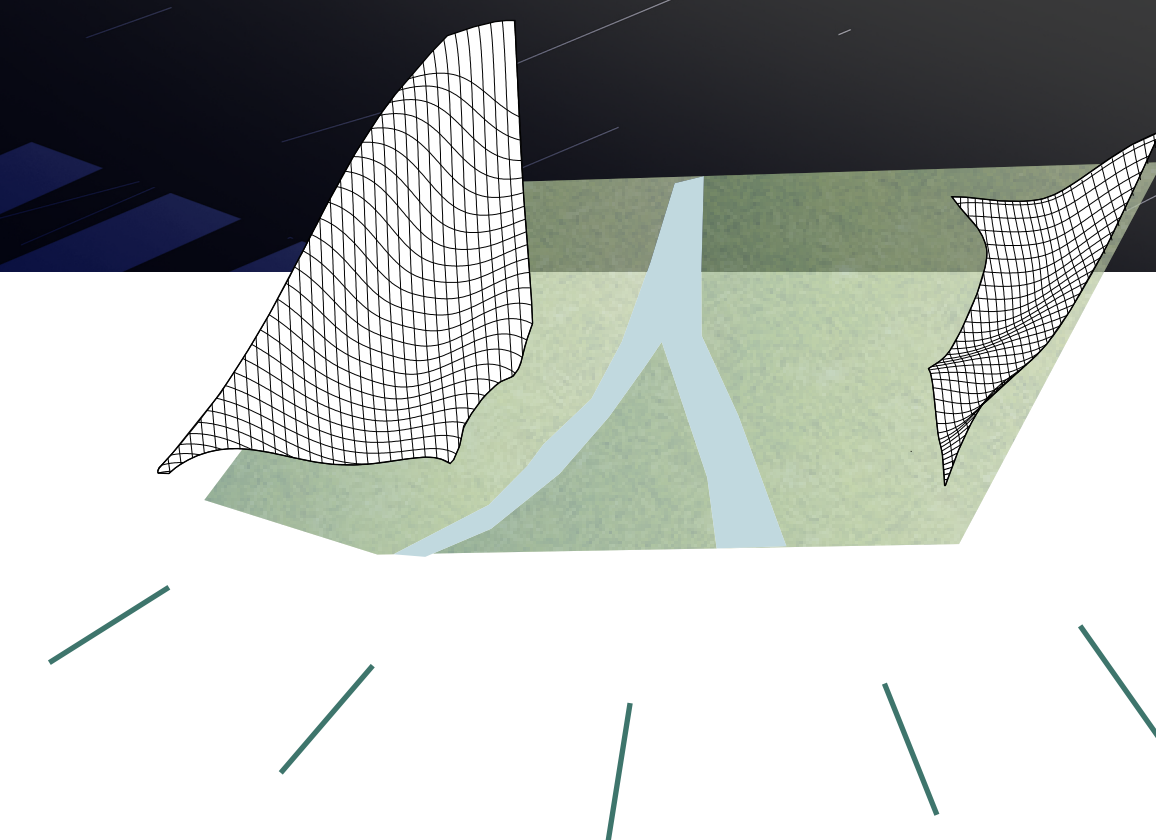

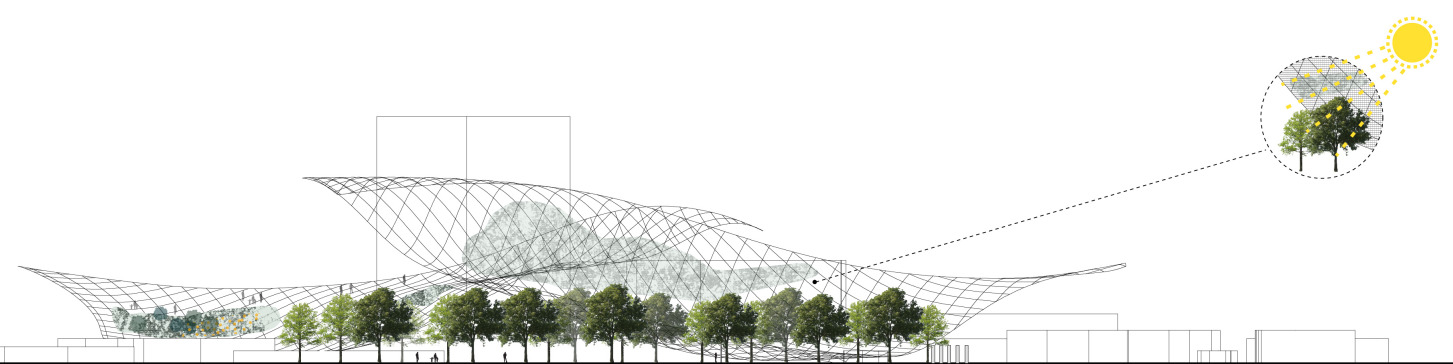
Siteplan

“The whole evolution of science indicates that the best grammar to think about the world is the grammar of change, not that of permanence. Of happening, not of being.

Thinking about the world as a set of events, of processes, of changes, is the way that allows us to better grasp it, understand it, describe it. It is the only way compatible with relativity. The world is not a collection of things, it is a collection of events.

The dynamics of the world is given by the equation that establishes which relationships exist between all the variables that describe it. It is a network of interconnected events, where the variables in play respect probabilistic rules, which incredibly, we largely know how to write.
