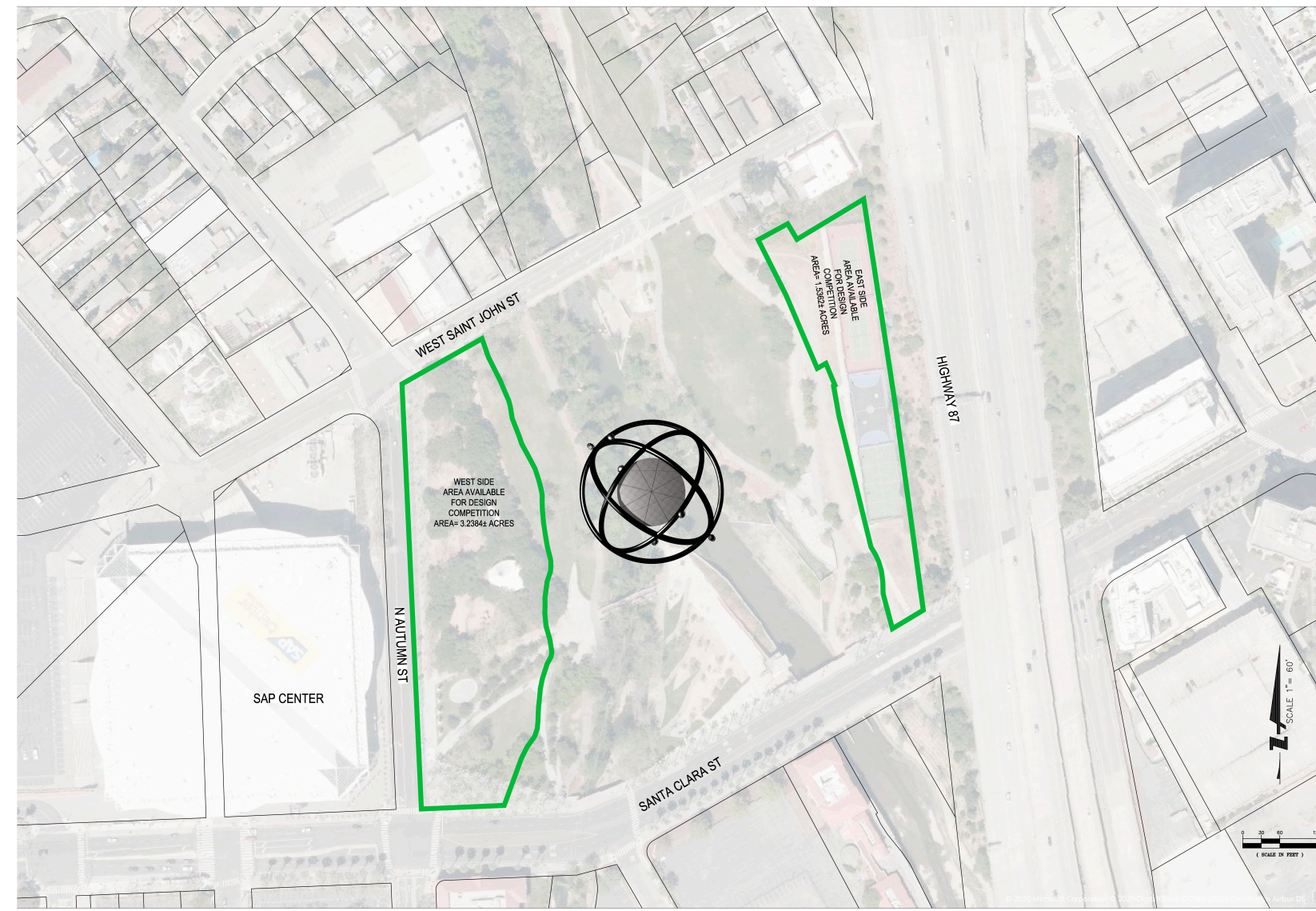


ICONIC LANDMARK | San José · California



The Low Trail, on the sides of the river, runs continuously underneath the bridges.

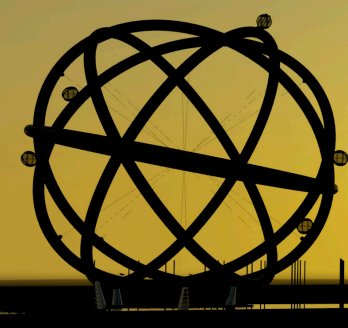
A number of stores within park limits creates an urban transition space, with pedestrian streets and continuity from Little Italy.

Open spaces are enhanced in order to preserve and promote the largest number of activities

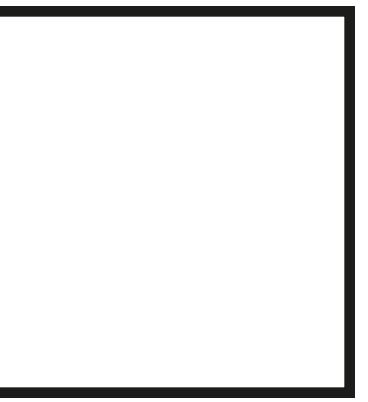
A bridge connects both sections of the river, crossing it from above. The ride can be accessed from a circular platform above the bridge

Access are reinforced to be able to enter the different areas of the park as well as the landmark



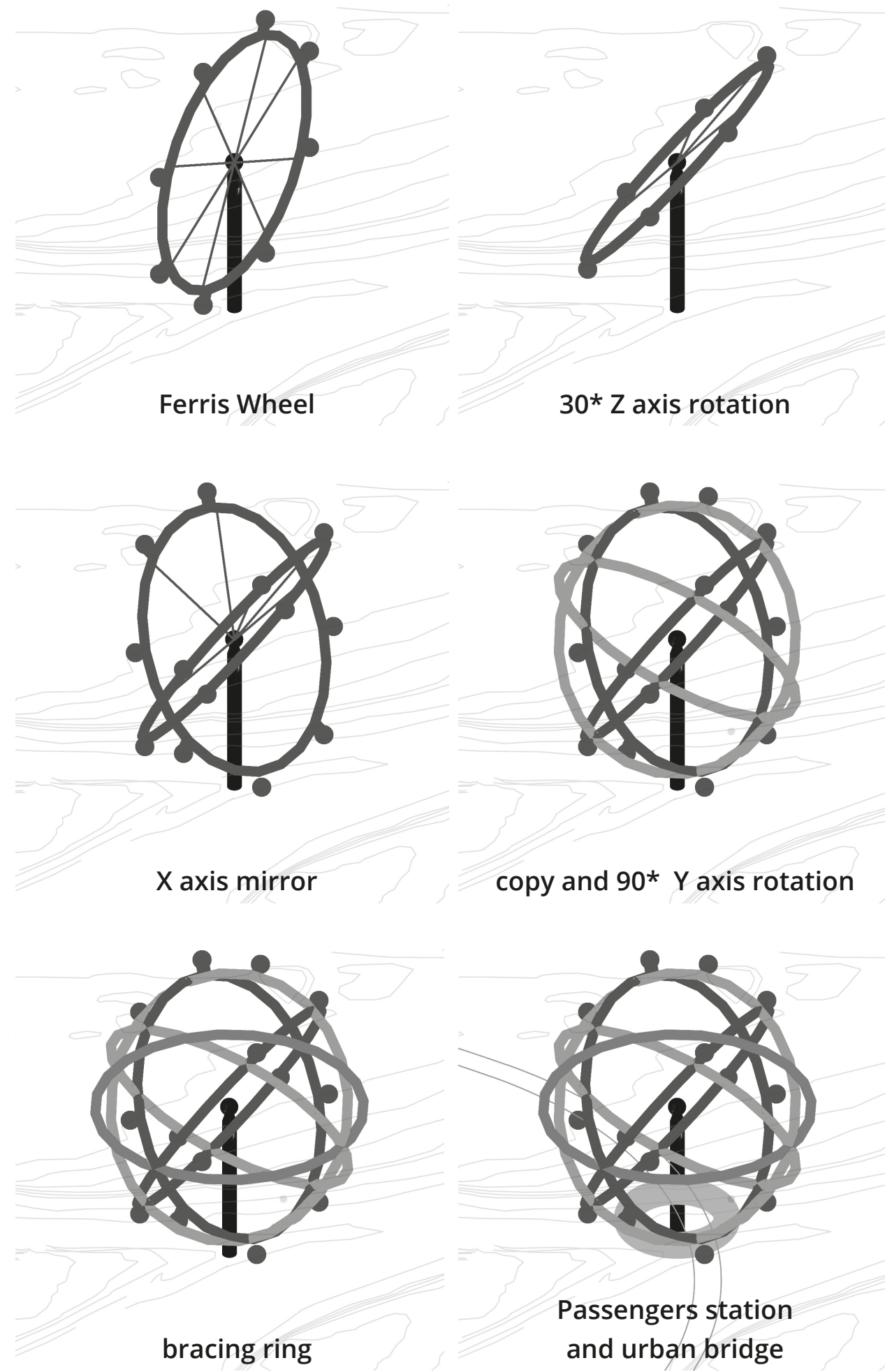

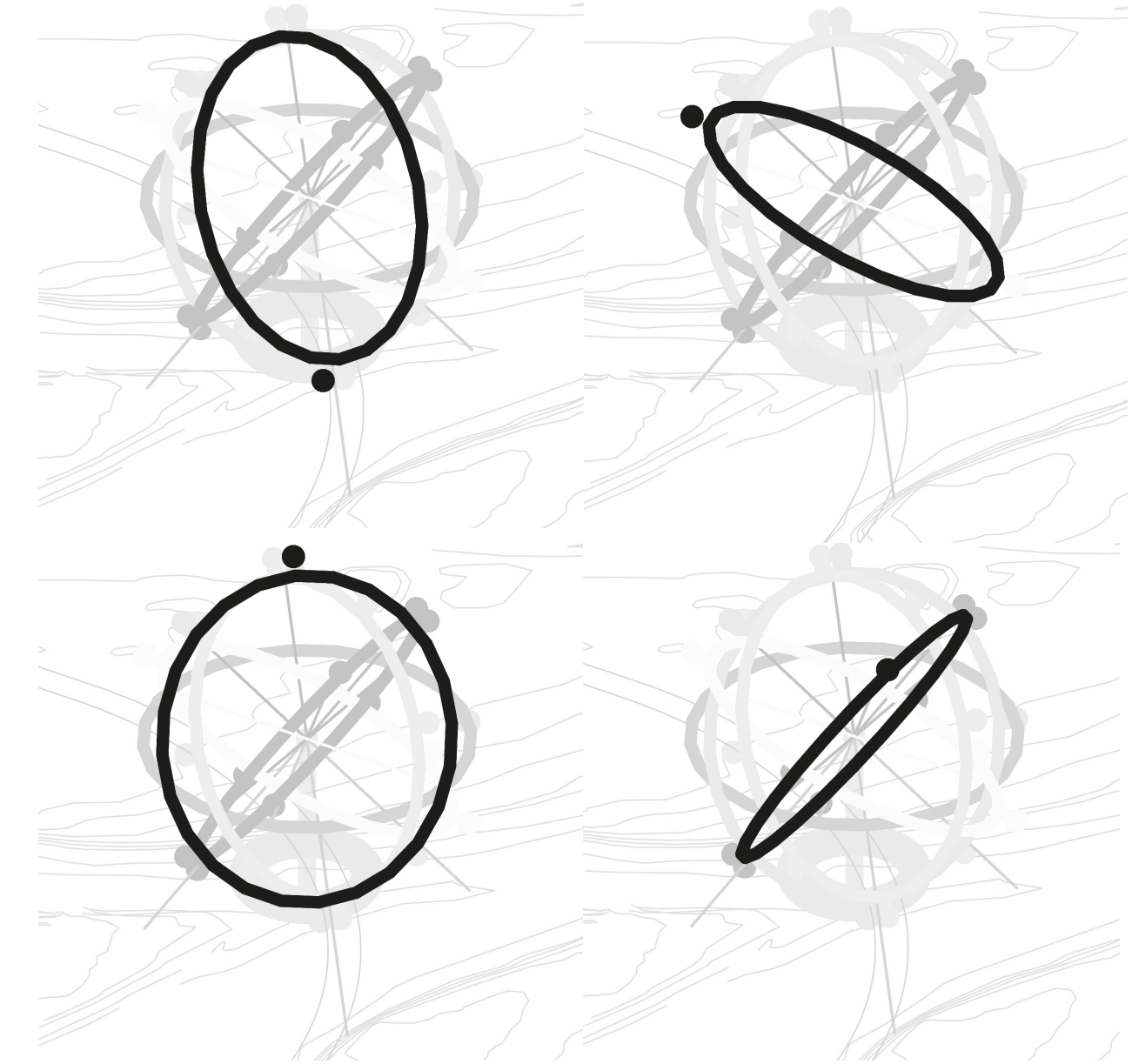
