

Project Statement

As the society comes together, Guadalupe River Park is an encounter between the Los Gatos Creek and Guadalupe River, getting with this a solid fusion between them.

In the park we have a unique concentration of professional figure skating champions, immortalized on monumental columns where we can see these artistic forms.

This mesh could serve as a big screen to make digital outdoor expositions, with this we have functionality on the ground level.
