Art at the scale of architecture, The San Jose Sculpture Garden takes inspiration from multiple disciplines including: art, architecture, landscape architecture, and even video games. With the future development of the surrounding downtown, the garden seeks to preserve the natural aspect of the river and build upon it. Based of Viking settlements in Scotland, the organic layout and ruins rests upon the man-made hillside creating a unique experience unlike any other garden. Sculptures are partially buried, embedding themselves into the landscape with seasonal florals decorating the hillside. On the highest point, a simple structure with potential to become an icon.
