On each bank, the ground slopes and rises to a height of 180 feet to form a gazebo from which you can observe the entire site. These two viewpoints are connected by a suspension bridge that spans the river. the project presents itself as a simple, almost primitive structure which highlights nature, slowness, in an increasingly fast world.

Despite its relatively low height, the project has a very strong presence. It consists of two large oblique elements made of concrete and supported by a series of pillars grouped together. These elements contrast with the lightness of the suspension bridge, the tension of which is ensured by two giant rocks suspended from the structure
