

The icon of Silicon Valley and San Jose at the confluence of two rivers is where nature, technology, history, social life and interaction converge. The design idea originates from the site's natural potential for grandeur with an icon being built around one of the main natural elements of the city, the Guadalupe River. The design resembles a transparent net that forms a ring around a natural landscape. The landmark is a dynamic oval pedestrian walkway passing through controllable photochromic dynamic glass structures as well as diagonal and disarrayed columns resembling reeds along a river similar to a cane brake.
