The proposal aims to achieve a concept which presents an iconic existence with a strong relation to its surrounding.

Project area located in San Jose which is tenth largest city of America and the largest urban center in Silicon Valley where is the global center for high technology, innovation, venture capital and social media.

The Wired welcomes visitors as a soaring landmark which remembers and celebrates the lands experiences. The aim was to create a memorable iconic pavilion.

The proposal is organized in order to allow visitors to connect directly with the landscape. While connecting with the landscape the structure offers an open amphitheater as an activated landscape. **The Wired** celebrates human and nature interaction through simple architectural gesture while maintaining as a place of great public destination.

The required structural stability for the elevated edges is provided by tension cables extending to the high tower.

The Wired highlights the innovative technological supremacy of Silicon Valley by incorporating novel construction techniques in a social, urban context.

The wired is visible from both immediate context and also from aerial viewpoints.

The landmark is located at the peak of the plot, and is directed towards the city center. the directionality is emphasized by a panoramic bridge, allowing views from different points of the city.
