

Expanding on the original San Jose light tower, our scheme creates six light towers, connected by bridges, which radiate light out from Silicon Valley's new conceptual center.

These towers become the Silicon Valley Light Towers Museum, where people from all over the world can explore, experience, and study the vast influence of Silicon Valley on the world.

The cable-stay bridges connect the towers both conceptually and physically. They represent the long history of bridges in the Bay Area. They clear span the riparian areas so they can remain undisturbed, and they allow opportunities to experience the rivers from unique perspectives.
