Extending from Guadalupe river lies an ephemeral sail on a bed of water, swaying with the wind and flow of people. It echoes the colors of its changing context, and its motion is operated by natural influences. The landmark consists of a series of thin iridescent membranes that hang from a top rail and cascade downwards, disappearing below the water and re-emerging on the East end of the park as a low-rise human-scale landscape. The project exhibits the history of Silicon Valley, one of maintained change and adaptations, it draws on the area's natural qualities and its technological character.
