

Inspired by the sustainable character, and the form simplicity, the Landscape Triangle orientates its legs to capture the biggest amount of solar energy in San Jose's latitude, 37° north. While, the horizontal element becomes a 90 feet high bridge that provides the best views of the city, but especially of the rivers. The looking down faces are softly illuminated by a veering blue light, recalling the proximity to the Pacific Ocean. By doing so, the triangle turns into a landmark also during the nights; the figure stands out among the buildings to define the city landscape.
