

*Split Baobab* has three structures: a large stone baobab tree, 175ft long, split open with a waterfall flowing through it to the west of the Guadalupe River, and an arts and environment education center along with a dance floor east of the river. The structures use the ancient and environmentally friendly construction method of rammed earth. The bottom part of the two buildings will be resurfaced with clay each year and welcomes poet laureates old and young to share poems with the community. The resurfacing would be a community event that enshrines community ownership of the monument.
