

SAN JOSE SKY WALK

A linear open-air pavilion serving as a community gathering space runs along N. Autumn Street, creating a permeable filter through which the rest of the park grounds can be experienced. This pavilion is then looped, shaped (reacting to the path of the Guadalupe River and Los Gatos Creek), and raised (conforming to the allowable buildable footprint).

The resulting hybrid bridge / cantilever structure—a dynamic form, illuminated at night, that constantly changes with the viewer's perspective—rises 200 ft above the landscape, providing a unique elevated promenade that will become a favorite destination for locals as well as tourists.
