


the ARCHITECTURE

Design concept inspired by California poppy flower. Copa De Oro pavilions (Cup of gold) will be a new breed of Architecture as social infrastructure. Two flame looking pavilions will locate on both sides of river to complement and extend existing green area. Combination of 3d-printed panels and adaptive LED lights designed to create unique signature look in suburban place.






the LANDSCAPE

Five-acres landscape of experimentation, inspired by the city's role as an emerging technology hub. Existing landscape and pavilion's curved roof merge into one continuous experience.

the **NET-ZERO**

Buildings will be modeled with geothermal wells system to demonstrate compliance trade-offs that are allowed within California Building Energy Efficiency Standards. Other technologies: Energy Modeling, PV Panels, Geothermal air conditioner and heating system.





the **PROGRAM**

Pavilions program include combination of commercial and non-commercial uses such as art museum, bar, cafe, visitor center, ice-cream, multipurpose concert hall, fitness center and sky deck with 360 degree views.
