

Confluence Slope acts as a gateway to the new Diridon neighbourhood. The sloped park draws views from downtown and the highway and offers panoramic sights of the Guadalupe river, Downtown and the valley and mountains beyond.

The characteristic wedge shape offers generous, shaded open spaces for community events such as farmers markets, fairs etc. at its low end, whilst creating creating a dramatic, sunny and transparent space in-between 90' tall columns at the narrow end. The sloped park is conceived as a botanical garden of indigenous and drought-resistant vegetation, reintroducing the local natural biotope in to the city.
