I imagined *Sunlight* to be part of the landscape throughout the Arena Green where it will encourage the community and visitors to walk explore the gardens and be part of their daily activity giving positive good energy that evokes imagination and wonder. *Sunlight* will be integrated into Arena Green where the real (actual plants, trees, and urban scape) will blend in with the glass panels. They are meant to act like portals where the viewers will place themselves in this imaginary world where they can get lost in it while appreciating the surroundings. The semi-transparency gives that glowing feel when back lit at night or by the sun and the overall imagery is dreamlike and is suppose to evoke well being. I hope the viewers will feel that and see something new every time they go by the works and come up with their own narrative transporting themselves to a fantastical world combine with the history, flora/fauna, and spirit of San Jose. I grew up in San Jose and think about the nature, diversity in ecologies, and the lively city it has become.

Sunlight is made of semi transparent glass panels that consist of photo-based pieces through out both areas of the Arena Green. It is comprised of 3 panels of glass per set making 3 sets that will be printed and etched on that will both be semi transparent, permanent and will not fade. Each panel is approx 8'x 4' or larger and will have a framing system around it on a concrete raised base. The artwork is a net zero energy design and uses sustainable materials that are environmentally friendly.

I would like to collaborate with the team for placement and scale of the works. Images of animals and vegetation from the ground up are seen with underground mysterious worlds, as well as the cosmos and orchards, and sprawling cities all inspired by the area. It will be a harmonious imaginary world where the viewers can place themselves in where the narrative begins with the sun high in the sky moving and traveling in the space then transforming to a floating forest world, planting itself in nature and then descending into a sunset wishing good thoughts and energy to all.
