

The "San Jose Wave Circle" is a landmark that represents the innovation of Silicon Valley, formally it's an elevated circle supported by four inclined columns, whose oscillating profile represents a "wave" in allusion to the transmission of data in electronic circuits, a form which additionally provides structural resistance to the building, which has a raised terrace at +140' (with floor and ceiling, in photovoltaic glass) where cafes, restaurants, bars, street furniture and trees are located. That thanks to the lighting systems, and its unique architecture, it acquires a strong presence in the cityscape, becoming a symbol of the Silicon Valley.
