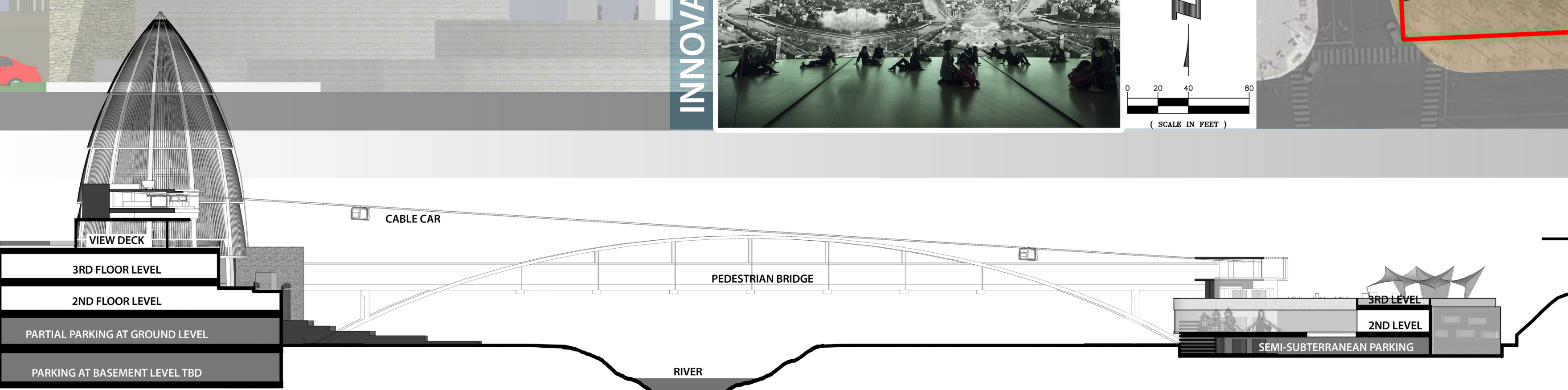


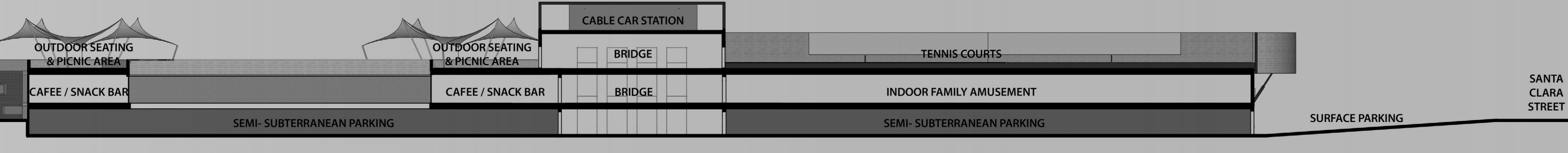
THE HUB:

This center will be the connecting bridge between the cultural past and the innovation of the future the region has produced and will serve as a confluence center for the surrounding community and people around the world.



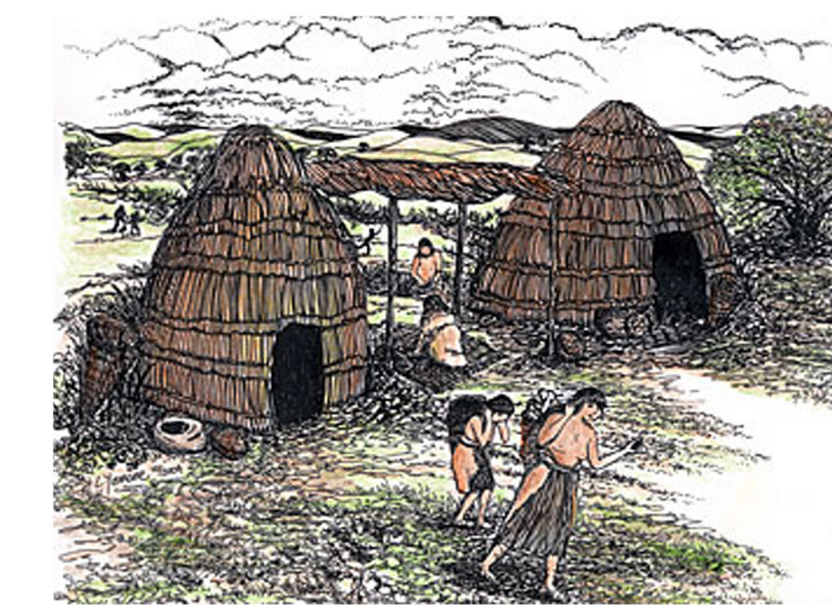
- NET ZERO BUILDINGS**
- NET ZERO BUILDING: (Project Design Feature)
 - Solar energy, radiant cooling system, Green wall, direct current power grid, water cistern to collect and recycle water, sewer heat exchange if possible.
 - Smart building using energy efficient lighting & HVAC with sensor, advance security system, and real time energy monitoring.
 - Light emitting material specifically on the observatory tower to self luminate during night time.
 - Natural ventilation and automated sun screens.

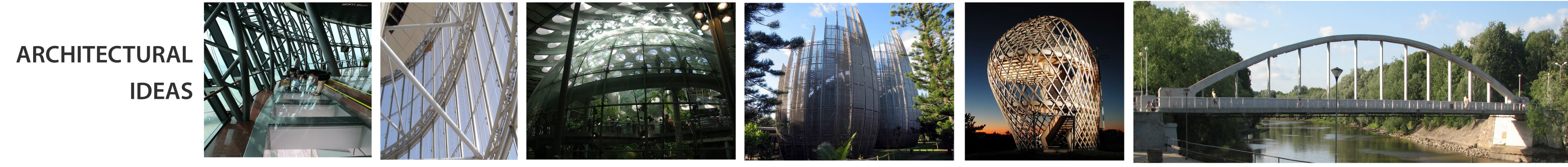


INSPIRATION - OHLONE TRIBE STRUCTURE

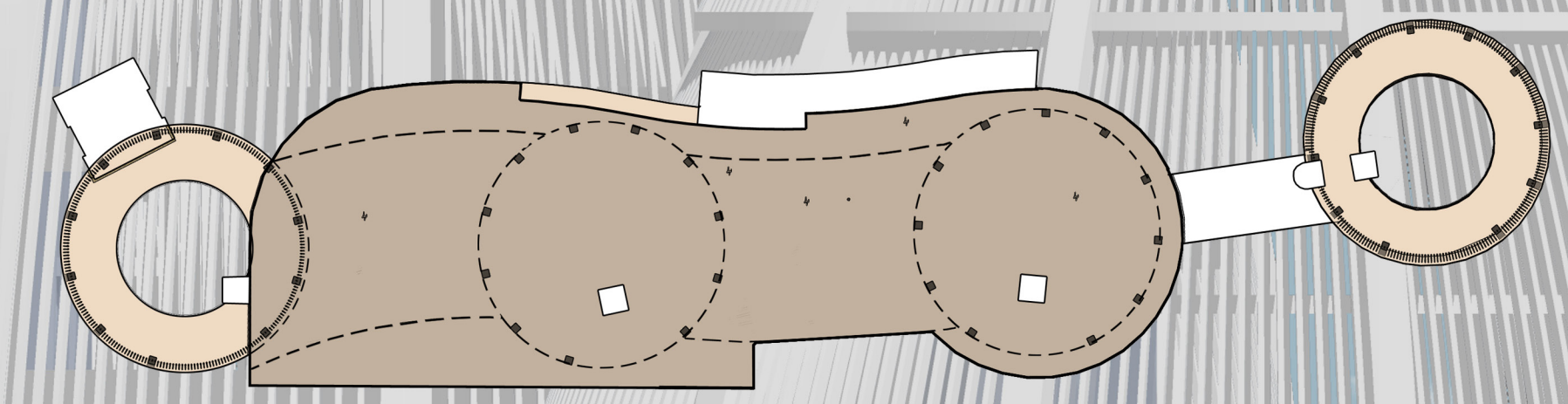


ELEVATION - PARK SIDE

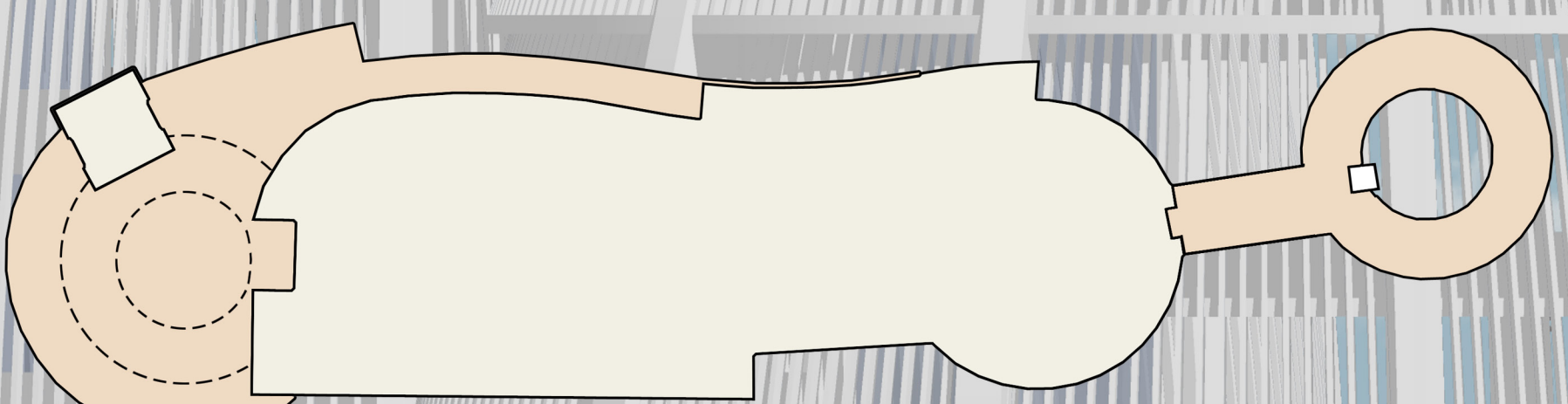

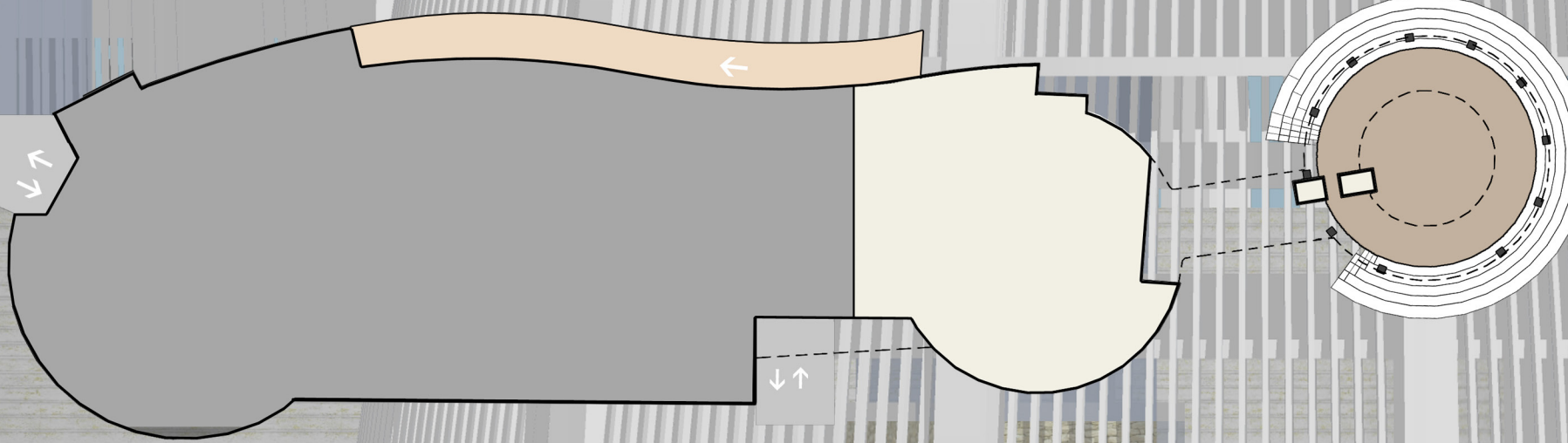

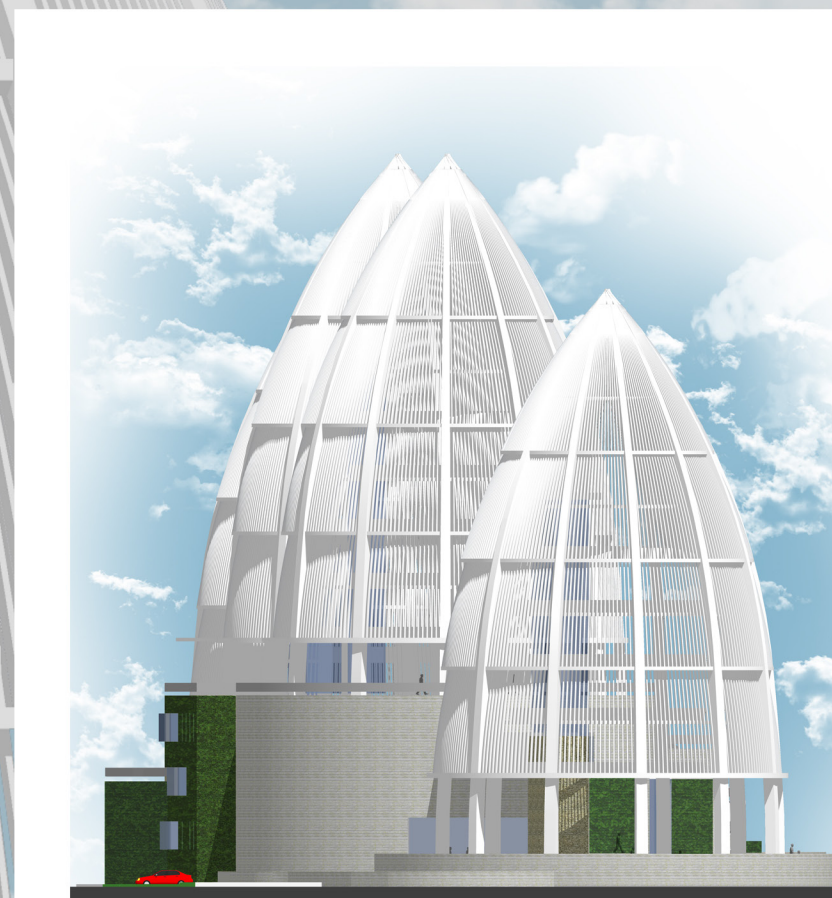
