The "San Jose Light Square" is a landmark that represents the innovation of silicon valley, conceptually it's inspired by the geometry of the electronics, since it is a perfect square (that delimits a central space, -the park-) supported by four long columns, formally similar to electronic chips and processors. It provides a 162' elevated observation terrace (covered in photovoltaic glass) where cafes, restaurants, bars, street furniture and trees are located. It has an attractive transparent LED screen facade, this added to its impressive and formally clean architecture acquires a strong presence in the landscape, becoming a symbol of the city.
