\$10,000 in scholarships to be awarded to local students headed to Brock University and Niagara College Students to share how COVID-19 has financially impacted their lives

April 20, 2020 – NIAGARA – PenFinancial Credit Union will be awarding \$10,000 to Niagara area students planning to head to Niagara College or Brock University in 2020. The *Truly Local Video Scholarship Contest* aims to encourage students graduating from Niagara area secondary schools to submit a two minute video, outlining how they have been financially impacted by COVID-19 and how the pandemic has made them think differently about the importance of community.

"In the wake of COVID-19, we have witnessed the impact of the financial security of many families across our communities and recognize some graduating high school students may now not have the financial means to attend post-secondary school." Stated Ken Janzen, the credit union's CEO. "We wanted to help in some way and feel that the video contest will be a welcomed creative diversion while they're isolated at home." Janzen continued.

Video entries will be judged on creativity, passion and overall appeal. A committee of community leaders will narrow down the entries received to the "Top 5", at which time will then be introduced to the public to vote for their favourite. Judges include Brock University President Gervan Fearon, DSBN Education Foundation Executive Director Laura Byers, Niagara College President Sean Kennedy, NCDSB Communications Officer Jennifer Pellegrini, and PenFinancial's CEO Ken Janzen.
