

# Health & Safety Plan - On Campus



## Before Re-Opening

- We'll be conducting an electrostatic disinfectant and antimicrobial deep clean treatment.
- Mattresses and mats will be replaced.
- Teachers participating in care for essential workers will be tested or self-quarantine for two weeks before returning.
- All teachers will submit updated medical forms.
- Teachers will be re-trained in: OSHA, Diaper Changing, Food Handling, and Cleaning (prep and performance).
- Teachers will sign COVID attestation and waiver.



## Doing Our Part

- We will maintain 30 days' worth of cleaning supplies and PPE at all times.
- Children exhibiting any illness symptoms will be immediately removed from the classroom and placed with administrators in separate area.
- Teachers will wear hair "up," and maintain short nails. Teachers may not wear jewelry.
- Teachers will be provided and must wear masks and other PPE.
- Teachers will be provided and must wear long sleeve tops.
- If a teacher becomes ill, they will leave the facility and the classroom will be disinfected immediately.
- We will constantly monitor and communicate all guidelines from the DOH and CDC to maintain and exceed best practices for the health & safety of our community.
- Children and teachers must be 72 hours fever free before re-entering the center.



## Doing Your Part

- All families must submit updated medical forms.
- Families must sign COVID attestation and waiver.
- Strollers will only be allowed in the vestibule area and will not be stored at school.
- Family arrival times should be announced 30 minutes in advance to allow center staff to prepare.
- Family pick up times should be announced 30 minutes in advance to allow center staff to prepare.
- We ask that you communicate regularly with us and be mindful of the health of the entire community.
- If you or your child have even mild symptoms, please stay home.
- Practice kindness and empathy with our teachers, staff and other families as we navigate this new



## Entering Vivvi

- Teachers will change clothing upon entering.
- Children and parents will have their temperature checked at drop off.
- Teachers will change children's clothing upon entering.
- No parents may enter beyond the vestibule area.
- No visitors will be allowed in the center. All tours will be virtual.
- Packages will be disinfected in the vestibule.
- Outdoor play will be restricted.
- Check in will be managed via teachers and personal cell phone. Communal use of iPads will be paused.



## In Our Classrooms

- A Fours class will be limited to 15 children.
- Additional hand sanitizing dispensers will be made available throughout the campus.
- Toys and equipment will be disinfected immediately after use.
- Sleeping mats will be disinfected after each use.
- Door handles will be wiped after each use.
- All surfaces will be wiped down hourly.
- Crib sheets will be changed daily.
- Cribs will be disinfected daily.
- Deep cleanings will occur nightly, including steaming of all furniture and rugs.
- Additional signage will be added throughout the classrooms for new policies and reminders.
- Teachers may not keep personal belongings in the classroom area.
- In person classes such as Super Soccer Stars and Library time will be suspended.
- Air will be purged daily.
