# Bring Back Summer Enrollments

## Integrate course sharing into your summer plan

Course sharing can greatly expand the range and depth of summer term offerings, giving students new options to catch up, get ahead, or relieve fall and spring scheduling pressures. Course sharing ensures quality and availability and allows institutions to share in the tuition revenue.

The first step in expanding the number of students you can serve is to select and pre-approve courses within CIC's course sharing network. Once courses are approved, ensure student advisors know which courses are available so they can get students enrolled in courses that meet their needs.



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*University of Mount Union* leveraged online courses during summer term for the first time in 2017 for 216 students. By 2021, summer **enrollment had increased to 579**, and revenue increased to **\$866,000**.
