## FUN GAMES

Games are a great way for children to listen and follow directions, participate in groups, learn to negotiate, lead and follow. Games encourage turn taking and build social skills.

### EXPERIENCE

Guess what's in the bag

Select some everyday objects from your home, objects that you know you have at least two of. Place a few objects in a bag. Let your child know you have placed some objects in the bag. Let your child feel inside the bag without looking. Ask them to feel one object whilst in the bag and identify the object. "What do you think it might be?", "What does it feel like?" Once the object is identified encourage your child to locate another of the same object.

### LEARNING

How is this supporting my child's learning?

This game provides children with an opportunity to label objects using a sense of touch and memory recall. The experience encourages the use of describing and labeling words, and also mathematical language e.g. the same, different etc.

### RESOURCES

What do I need?

A bag which will store a number of items from your home. Choose simple everyday objects. We suggest up to 5 objects for younger children and 8 or more objects for older children.
