Recognising letters and understanding how letters make words as well as recognizing sounds, developing writing skills and learning about books and storytelling are all valuable early literacy experiences.

EXPERIENCE

The first letter of my name

Together with your child search for things in your home. Search for things that start with the same letter as your child's name. "Mia, lets find things that start with M" e.g. Magazine, Mum, Movie, Muffin, Magnet, Mushroom, Machine, Mail, Mat, Mask etc Sounding out the first sound of your child's name can support them to locate objects.
