Collect a variety of kitchen utensils such as pots, pans, ladles, sticks, metal trays, carton boxes and tins. Let the child sit comfortably and ensure the objects are within the reach of the child. You may role model to the child how to bang on the objects at first, and then sit back to watch your child become a musician.
