EXPERIENCE

Treasure hunt

Find things that roll. Share an object with your child, rolling it to each other as you sit on the floor. Suggest you search together for other object that might roll. Talk about what makes the object roll; point to the curve of the object. Collect the items in a basket. Sit together and test each object, does it roll, how far can each object roll?

2 year olds love to search for things and collect them. Older children enjoy testing how things work. This experience encourages children to develop an understanding of the properties of objects, identifying objects with similar characteristics, learning words to describe and predicting the capability of objects. You may like to introduce a ramp or slope to this game, and explore motion and speed of each object.
