Vitamin B ₂ has been called the "vitamin for fat metabolism" and the "vitamin for skin and mucosa." Deficiencies of this vitamin can cause symptoms such as fatigue, eczema, dermatitis and stomatitis to occur easily.

Chocola BB Children's Syrup contains vitamin B₂ as its main ingredient, along with vitamins B₁ and B₆ and biotin, which is known as vitamin for anti-dermatitis. It is a peach-flavored syrup form for children to swallow easily.

Recommended for improving symptoms, such as eczema, acne, dermatitis and stomatitis, in little children aged 3 months or over, as well as for supplementation of vitamin B 2 when physical strength is decreased during or after illness.

Take twice a day after meals, using the measuring cup provided to measure the dose

Precautions for Dosage and Administration

When allowing children (3 months-15 years) to take the medicine, a guardian must be present to watch and tell them how to take it.

Riboflavin Sodium Phosphate (Vitamin B 2 phosphate ester)	19 m g	Supports healthy skin and mucosa Aids fat metabolism, converting it to energy.
Pyridoxine Hydrochloride (Vitamin B 6)	12 m g	Supports healthy skin and mucosa. Aids protein metabolism, converting it to energy.
Thiamine Nitrate (Vitamin B 1 nitrate)	6 m g	Aids carbohydrate metabolism, converting it to energy.
Nicotinamide	20 m g	Supports healthy skin and mucosa.
Biotin	250µg	Supports healthy skin and mucosa and suppresses inflammation of the skin.

Inactive Ingredients

Sodium benzoate, ethanol (0.1 mL or less), citric acid, sodium citrate, D-sorbitol, paraben, flavor, hydrogenated maltose starch syrup, glycine, propyl gallate, povidone, DL-malic acid, pH adjuster

Precautions for Ingredients

Taking this medicine may cause urine to turn bright yellow, but this is due to assimilation of the vitamin B $_2$ contained in the medicine, with part of it being excreted in the urine. It is not a cause for concern.

Consultation

1. If the following symptoms are observed after taking this drug, these may be adverse reactions. Immediately discontinue the use of this medicine and show this informational leaflet to a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

- 2. The following symptom may be observed after taking this medicine. If this symptom persists or worsens, discontinue the use of this medicine and show this informational leaflet to a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson for a consultation.

- 3. If symptoms do not improve even after taking the medicine for about 1 month, stop taking the medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson, bringing this informational leaflet with you.

Precautions for Storage and Handling

- 1. Store sealed in a cool place away from direct sunlight.
- 2. Keep out of reach of children.
- 3. Keep refrigerated after opening the bottle, and use it as soon as possible.
- 4. Do not transfer to a different container. Also, do not transfer other medications, etc., into this container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality.)
- 5. After administration, rinse the measuring cup, and store it securely with the syrup.
- 6. Do not take medicine that has exceeded its expiration date.
