Scopolamine hydrobromide hydrate	0.25mg	Reduces sensory confusion caused by riding in vehicles.

Carrageenan, corn starch, D-mannitol, l-menthol, flavor, red ferric oxide, dimethylpolysiloxane, refined stevia extract, cellulose, povidone, silicon dioxide

When not to use the product

If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions/incidents are more likely to occur.

- 1. This drug should not be taken together with the following drugs:
 - Other medicine for motion sickness, cold medicine, antipyretics/analgesics, sedatives, expectorant, indigestion and heartburn relief, internal medicine containing antihistamines, etc. (such as internal medicine for rhinitis and medicine for allergies)
- Do not operate vehicles or machinery after taking this drug.
 (Symptoms such as sleepiness, blurred vision, and abnormal brightness may occur.)

Consultation

- 1. The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before administration.
 - 1. Patients undergoing medical treatment from a physician
 - 2. Pregnant women or women suspected of being pregnant
 - 3. The elderly
 - 4. Patients who have experienced allergic symptoms associated with drugs, etc.
 - 5. Persons with the following symptoms:
 Urination difficulty
 - 6. Persons diagnosed as having the following: Glaucoma, heart disease
- 2. If the following symptoms are observed after taking this drug, these may be adverse reactions, so immediately discontinue the use of this drug, and show this instruction leaflet to your

physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

Dry mouth, constipation, drowsiness, blurred vision
