### **Safety Considerations**





### **Pinching Hazards**

There is a pinching hazard due to the quick release feature on the PA-QR1 actuator, which has exposed moving parts. Take caution during use to prevent your hands from being pinched.



### Free Falling Load

When the quick release is engaged, care must be taken to avoid an unsecured load from rapidly dropping and potentially causing damage to equipment or harm to humans.



### **Quick Release Feature Engagement**

The quick release can be engaged by either pulling the cable with an installed lever, or moving the plastic housing by hand. In order to activate the quick-release feature, a force greater than 70 lbs must be applied to the linear actuator in the pull or push direction. If the typical load is less than this, the user can temporarily apply the load by pulling or pushing on the linear actuator. Warning! Do not move plastic housing by hand when load is applied.





### **Setting Up the Quick Release**

#### **Pull Cable**

The PA-QR1 actuator comes with a pull cable for engaging the quick release from up to 4.92 ft away. The cable should be installed in a way that limits how bent it is, as this can make it harder to engage the quick release function. The included cable can be used with any handle or pull method that will pull the cable by 0.55".

#### AC-32 Quick Release Lever

The AC-32 Quick Release Lever was designed to perfectly pair with our PA-QR1 Quick Release Actuator. Adding this component to your order is something we highly recommend, unless you have an alternative lever that can be used. This lever can be purchased separately, and comes with an attached cable that can replace the cable included with the PA-QR1.

#### To replace the included cable with the AC-32:

1. Remove the lid that covers the existing cable end and the plastic housing on the PA-QR1 by pulling the lid up.

2. Remove the cable barrel-style end from the plastic housing. Use a flat head screwdriver to assist, if necessary.

3.Transfer the spring to the AC-32 cable – the steel part at the end of the new cable is a bit bigger than that of the previous cable. Apply force to make the spring move passed the cable end.



fig 3. Transfer spring from housing to AC-32 cable end.

4. Insert the AC-32 cable barrel-style end (found at the end of the cable, farthest from the lever). Ensure that the spring is inserted between the linear actuator cable housing and the cable barrel-style end. Use a flat head screwdriver to assist, if necessary. The cable barrel-style end sits on the plastic housing. The spring and the barrel feature supports holding the cable end in place within the plastic housing.



fig 4. Insert AC-32 cable end with spring into housing.

5. Place the lid back onto the cable housing on the PA-QR1.


### **Using the Quick Release**






