Mission

Orangutan Outreach protects orangutans in their native forests of Borneo and Sumatra while providing care for orphaned and displaced orangutans until they can be returned to their natural environment. If they cannot be released, the organization ensures they have a life of dignity and the best possible long-term care.

Intro

Orangutan Outreach raises funds, distributed quarterly, for their partners who run large orangutan rescue centers in Borneo and Sumatra. At these facilities, specially trained teams rescue, provide care for, and rehabilitate orphaned and displaced orangutans with the end-goal of releasing them back into the wild. Once they've returned to the forests, specialists follow the orangutans and make sure they're thriving, reproducing and staying healthy and safe.

In situations where orangutans can't be released back into the wild, Orangutan Outreach remains committed to providing care for them. They provide funds to create forested islands and build sanctuary spaces—which can be incredibly expensive. Accepting crypto donations with The Giving Block has helped Orangutan Outreach reach a new audience and created a new revenue stream that is helping them protect orangutans for many years to come.



Onboarding

In the beginning of their crypto journey, Orangutan Outreach was met with resistance from their board members. It came from a place of misunderstanding around cryptocurrency and how the organization would accept and use crypto donations. The key to success was education. Richard Zimmerman, Executive Director, showed them that The Giving Block would be set up as a giant catcher's mitt to only receive donations. There was no plan for the organization to invest in crypto, only hold it or convert it to dollars. Then, one day, they received a 169 ETH (\$389,000) donation from the Bored Ape Yacht Club, a hugely popular NFT project. That's when everyone at Orangutan Outreach truly saw the potential in crypto donations.

Platform Features

One key factor that led to this success was The Giving Block's support team, which helped Orangutan Outreach overcome their hurdles. Specifically, they broke down barriers and resistance surrounding the nature of crypto, understanding market volatility, and hesitancy around adopting new technologies. In this way Orangutan Outreach was set up to receive crypto correctly from day one.

Defining Success

The 169 ETH donation from the Bored Ape Yacht Club was huge, but it wasn't the only crypto donation success Orangutan Outreach has seen. As of December 2021, they've raised more through crypto donations than their entire revenue from 2020.

At the end of the day, what matters most is the impact these donations allow them to make. Now, Orangutan Outreach has the funding in place to expand the sanctuary space for the 100+ orangutans who can't go back into the wild. It also allows them to fund new projects, train and educate new veterinarians and help cover the costs to transport veterinary specialists from around the world to provide care for orangutans in need.

Now, thanks to crypto donations, instead of having to set up a capital campaign and worry about falling short of their goal, Orangutan Outreach can start with a pool of funds they can hold onto—and hopefully grow—until they're needed in the field.

"We're going to incorporate crypto into everything we do moving forward. I'm not used to having the luxury of this arsenal and war chest behind me, but we're going to make it bigger so we can do more good work."
