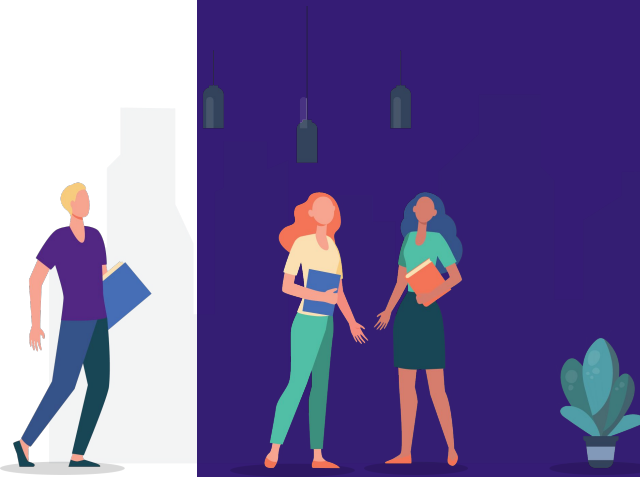


This or That Activity

Activity Purpose:

The purpose of this activity is to engage learners with each other so they can begin to develop a learning community and familiarize you and the learners with basic features and functions of Engageli.

Overview of Activity

- Instructor presents learners with a series of poll questions with two choices that can be:
 - a pair of images or words
 - on any topic or related to the course.
- Tablemates work together to choose options and explain why
- Instructor:
 - shares poll results
 - facilitates class discussion
 - encourages learners to share the personal or group ideas through the chat or at the podium.

3. Add Engageli Stickers to allow learners to choose
