With new requirements placed on Independent Study programs from AB 130 and AB 167, School Pathways' PLS has released a suite of new features to simplify and streamline these provisions.



Engagement Logs

With School Pathways' new Engagement Logs, users can track **Synchronous Instruction, Live Interactions, and Academic Progress** to meet AB 130 and AB 167 requirements.

Educators can simply check boxes in the platform to count engagement as they go or bulk upload student engagements from a spreadsheet.

Either way, tracking required engagements in School Pathways' PLS enables schools to easily centralize information and take action when reengagement steps or reporting is needed.






Tiered Reengagement List

Based on overall activity logs, PLS also **automatically populates a Tiered Reengagement List** with any students who do not meet 60% attendance in a single week. Teachers can also manually add students to this list as they see fit.

This view aggregates students over time, and there's a button to **send emails to families** to alert them of a students' missed work and lack of engagement.
