Help Keep the Sterile Field Sterile

AORN recommendations: "Unsterile equipment...should be covered on the top, bottom, and sides with sterile barrier materials before being introduced to or brought over a sterile field." ¹

Improving the sterility of draping techniques can help reduce the risk of increases in hospital costs and post-operative infections. ²

Using C-Armor

Effective sterility maintenance

- Adhere the C-Armor drape above the sterile field line to help maintain the sterile field
- Help reduce the risk of contamination with five-sided coverage of equipment introduced to the sterile field

Ease of use

- Attach and detach the C-Armor drape simply and quickly during procedures with the fastener tabs
- Allow for multiple rotations with a single drape due to an innovative design
- Reposition the drape easily, as the C-arm rotates, with a patented inverted pouch design

Efficiency

- · Help promote procedural standardization by using only one barrier per procedure
- Reduce the need for excess materials, steps and workflow changes

Form and Function

- Strong adhesive ensures a secure grip on the table above the sterile field line
- 2 Drape lies flat against the table when not in use for minimal disruption of surgical access
- Three fastener tabs offer easy deployment and security when the drape is not deployed
- Aluminum band assists in supporting the drape above the sterile field level when deployed
- 5 Drape helps protect the C-arm from fluid damage
- 6 Five-sided protection helps maintain the sterile field
