Find similar designs in seconds with a simple drag and drop—you do not need to be a legal professional or even be familiar with legal terminology to use *Design Search*!


Lower your risk of infringing upon someone else's design in a few simple steps.

Pick an image, drawing, product photo, or even prototype rendering, and drop it into *Design Search*. You can easily upload an image too, the choice is yours.








## Image crop

Cropping ensures that your image does not contain any irrelevant information such as other images or designs.








## Time to refine

Refine your search by adding keywords, assignee/current assignee, application/issue date, and Locarno code to ensure accurate and relevant results.








### View results and filter further

Search results are shown according to visual similarity. The same filters as on the search page can be found on the left.








# Go big

You can enlarge the patent images within the search results. Simply click on a patent image to select and enlarge it.








## Care to compare?

# Best practices





- Design Search is designed to search for design patents.
- Use clear line drawings on a plain white background for better results.
- Other images can be used, but they should be cropped to focus on one clear element.
- Eliminate shadows, reflections, wording, and any other irrelevant elements to improve search accuracy.
- Try using different angles of an item in an image for better results.

- Don't use less than optimal angles for your image search.
- Don't use blurry images or images that have dark backgrounds.
- Don't use exploded-view drawings.
