

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE **TESSELLATION MAZE**

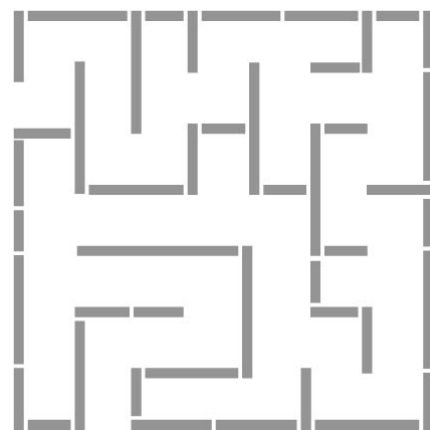
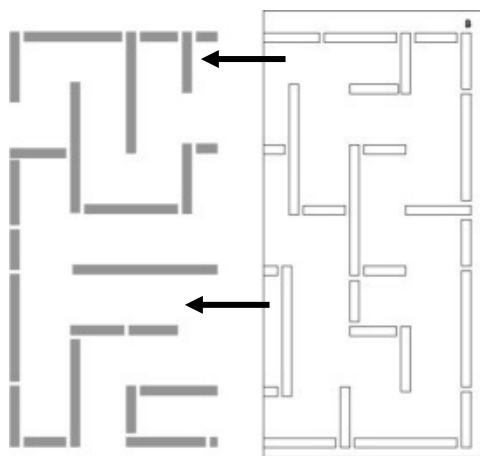
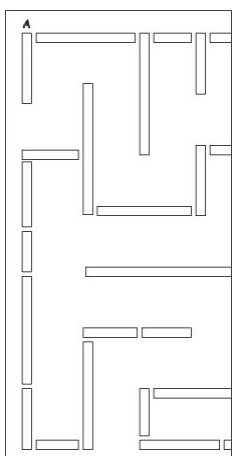
Product Number: 13-2W-044

SIZE: One application approximately 8 feet wide x 8 feet long. Can be re-applied multiple times for larger mazes in increments of 8 feet. Available in multiple colors. Pictured to the left.

ESTIMATED PAINT TIME: 1-2 people for 1-2 hours for one application, 2-4 people for 2-4 hours for 16 ft by 16 ft and 4-6 people for 4-6 hours for 16 ft by 32 ft

READ FIRST: Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Place STENCIL A, shown below left, in desired location and paint. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, then remove STENCIL A. Align STENCIL B as shown below middle, placing STENCIL B right next to the painted STENCIL A. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, and remove STENCIL B. It should appear as below right. Note: STENCIL A and STENCIL B can be taped together and applied in one step.

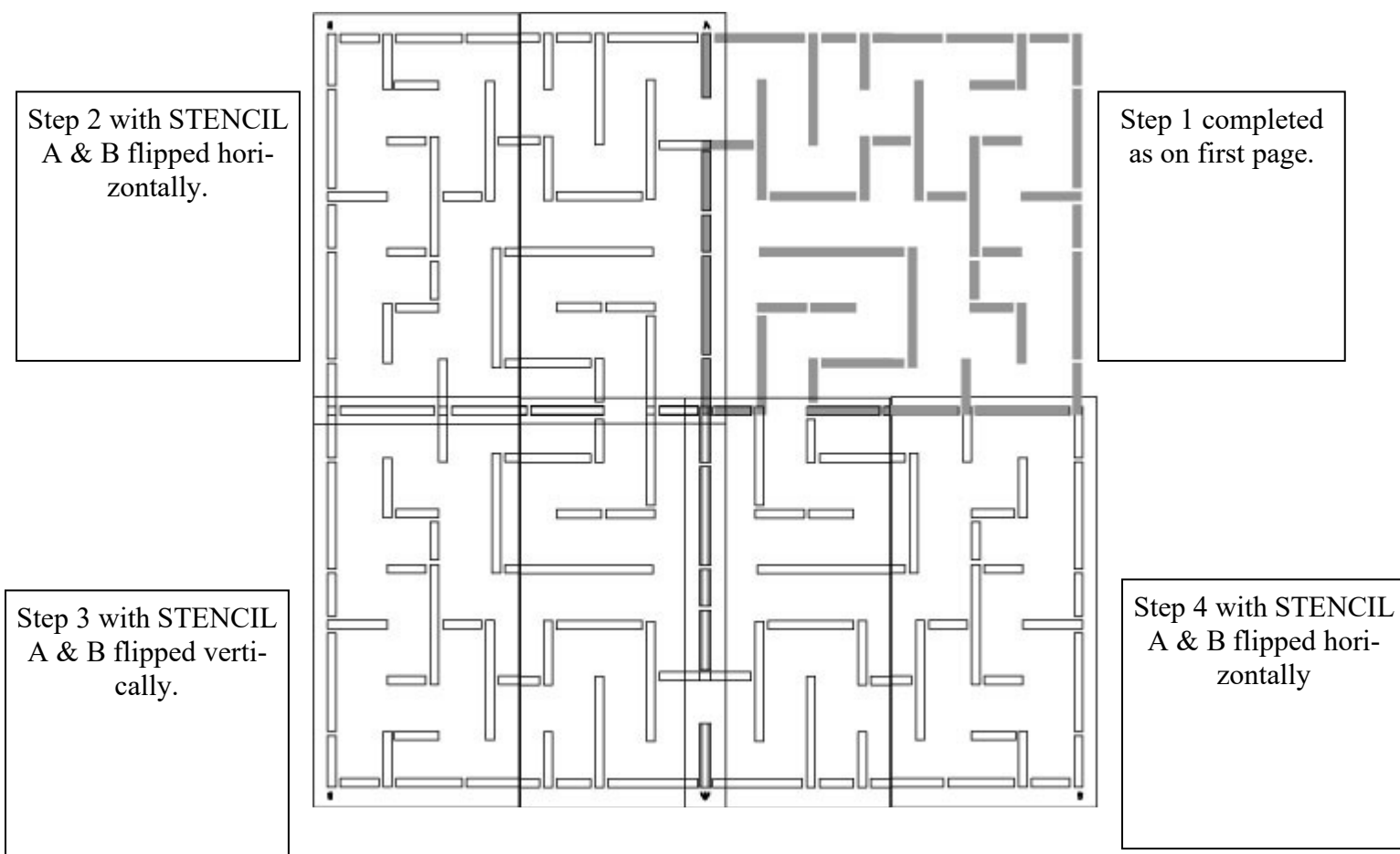


2. If desired, paint the gaps and fill in the path for a more stylized finish appearance.
3. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before use
4. To create a repeating, true tessellation configuration using this stencil, follow directions on the following sheet.

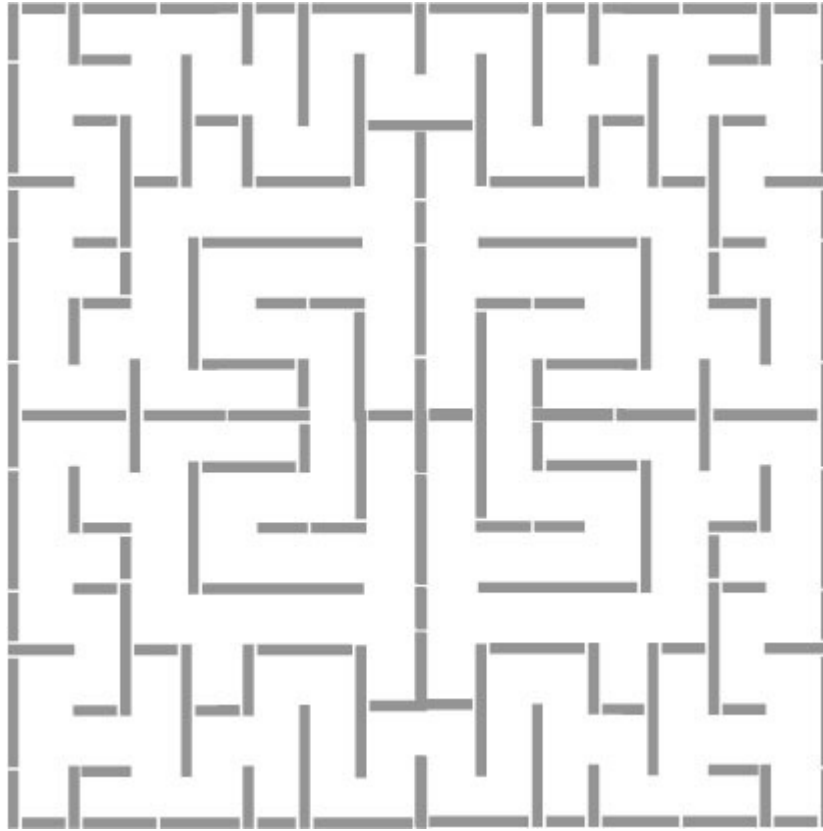
INSTRUCTIONS FOR A TRUE TESSELLATION:

After completing instructions in Step 1 on the preceding page, the next series of instructions will require rotating and flipping each stencil.

1. Tessellation gets applied in quadrants with both stencils used to create each. The upper left quadrant should be complete as shown in Step 1 above and as shown as in the upper right corner of the figure below. You will be applied each quadrant in a counterclockwise order. Flip STENCIL A and B horizontally as shown in Step 2 at upper left in figure below, and paint. Flip STENCIL A & B vertically as shown in Step 3 as shown in the lower left corner of the figure below, and paint. Finally, in Step 4, flip Stencil A & B horizontally as shown in bottom right corner of the figure below. Each time painting, repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.



2. The completed true tessellation maze should appear as below:



3. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before use.
