### TONS OF FUN REUSABLE STENCIL PACKAGE

#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USA MAP WITH CAPITALS & OCEANS Product Number: 11-3W-014

Completely read "General Instructions." Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Place STENCIL A, B and C in the desired location. Using the 1" brushes, paint the state outlines and the bodies of water names. Capitals depicted by the stars can be painted now or after the fields of each state are painted in step 3. Repeat paint 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.



- 2. Remove STENCILS, one at a time when dry. If desired, use a 1/2" brush to paint gaps along state outlines and stencil seams. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.
- 3. Use various colors of paint with rollers and brushes to fill in the fields of the states. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.
- 4. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before use.

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#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SHAPES THAT SHAPE YOU UP

Product Number: 11-1W-004 SIZE: approximately 11.75 – 21 inches each ESTIMATED PAINT TIME: depends on selected pattern. FIRST READ: Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

 Using various sized brushes or rollers, paint each stencil as desired. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, and remove stencil. Allow to dry for 24 hours before use.

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#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SHAPES THAT SHAPE YOU UP LINE

Product Number: 11-1W-004

**SIZE:** depends on desired spacing between each shape. One set of each shape spaced approximately 6 inches apart is approximately 12 feet 8 inches long. Width is 11.75-21 inches wide.

**ESTIMATED PAINT TIME:** approximately 1 – 2 people for less than 1 hour.

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Arrange stencils in desired pattern with equal desired spacing between the sheets. Chalking may be needed for accuracy. The image below shows one of various patterns:



- 2. Using various sized brushes or rollers, paint each stencil as desired. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, and remove stencil. Allow to dry for 24 hours before use.
- 3. Shapes can be reapplied to create longer lengths or different patterns. Letters or numbers can be painted after shapes are completely dry.

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#### SKYSCRAPER HOPSCOTCH

Product Number: 12-2W-036

SIZE: approximately 16 feet long x 4 feet wide. ESTIMATED PAINT TIME: Full color: approximately 1-2 people for 4-8 hours. Partial outline: 1-2 people for 3-6 hours

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Place STENCIL A in desired location. Paint clouds, building outlines and squares for numbered spaces. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, Using chalk, mark the alignment holes on each side of the bottom of STEN-CIL A. Remove STENCIL A. It should look like the illustration to below, right.







2. Infill building areas with paint if desired. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. It should look like illustration below.





3. Place STENCIL B below painted pavement and match alignment holes as shown below, left (a). Paint outlines and squares and after drying, remove STENCIL B (b). Infill building areas with paint (c) if desired. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.





After painted pavement is completely dry, return STENCIL A and STENCIL B one at a time over painted pavement, using alignment holes and squares to ensure proper alignment. Paint the rectangular windows on each stencil, let dry and remove. Repeat for STENCIL B.





5. After completely drying, place and align the numbered cutouts within spaces starting with "1" at bottom. Paint as desired with thin brush. Let dry. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Once completely dry, remove numbered cut outs. The stencil is complete and should look as illustrated below. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours.



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#### FOUR SQUARE (LARGE)

Product Number: 11-2W-015 SIZE: approximately 16 feet each side ESTIMATED PAINT TIME: approximately 2 – 4 people for 1 – 2 hours. EIPST PEAD: Completely read "Conoral Instructions"

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Align STENCIL A and B along the edges as shown below and tape.



2. Paint **only** the outlines of each stencil. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then, when fully dry, remove stencils. It should look like as follows:





3. Locate and align outline of STENCIL A over one side of the painted outlines, lapping over the dried painted outline. Tape and then align STENCIL B to STENCIL A and tape as shown below:



4. Paint **only** the outlines of each stencil. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then when fully dry, remove stencils. It should look like as follows:



5. Complete other two quadrants of game as in steps 1-4 above until all four quadrants are painted. The painted pavement should look as follows:





6. Use 9" rollers to fill in the fields of each quadrant with desired paint. Repeat paint to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.



7. Take STENCIL A and STENCIL B and align corners over painted pavement as shown below, one at a time. (Note that there are different sequences of numbers that are typically used – some position the "1" across from the "4"). Use small brushes to paint numbers, repeating to desired vividness and drying after each application. Remove each stencil when fully dry.





8. It should then look like illustration below. Use small brushes to fill in the gaps along outlines if desired.





9. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before use.

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### CHESS/ CHECKERBOARD

Using the Chess, Checkers and Borders: (LARGE), Product Number: 11-1W-008

SIZE: approximately 15 feet each side

**ESTIMATED PAINT TIME:** approximately 2 – 4 people for 1-2 hours.

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Lay stencil in desired location. Using rollers, paint each square alternating colors, let dry and relocate stencil adjacent to painted squares as shown below on following steps, adding to each completed set of squares. (Or chalk out all squares for complete board then paint) Repeat this process to create 8 painted squares across and 8 squares down until it is complete as shown below, far.







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- 2. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.
- 3. Allow to dry for 24 hours before use.

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#### CIRCLE UP (LARGE)

Product Number: 11-2W-010 SIZE: diameter (width) approximately 18 feet ESTIMATED PAINT TIME: approximately 2 – 4 people for 1 – 2 hours.

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. This stencil is composed of two (2) stencils as shown below. Familiarize yourself with the markings before proceeding as labeled below.



- 2. Locate the center point of the circle. To mark where the circle would generally be laid out take a piece of 9' string. Hold one end of the string at the centerpoint and position a piece of chalk at the other end of the string. While holding the end at the center point, and keeping the string taught, create a circle by rotating around the center point. This is recommended to ensure the approximate desired position of the stencils.
- 3. The next several steps require that the stencil be positioned, painted, dried and re-oriented (flipping over horizontally and vertically). Please note the following:



- a. When removing stencils, use one person positioned at each end of the stencil and lift at the same time. Do not roll the stencil or lift unevenly.
- b. Use a 2" brush to paint the Circle Outline.
- c. Use a 2" brush to paint the Hour Marker Outlines.
- d. Re-paint the outline 1-2 more times at each step to achieve desired vividness.
- e. Wipe stencil dry after each step and upon completion.
- f. Familiarize yourself with the sequence of laying out the stencils as indicated on the following page and use during application for reference.
- 4. Position STENCIL 1/A to align along the marked line on the pavement. This is the starting stencil. Mark the Alignment Circles and Alignment Rectangles using chalk. Paint STENCIL 1/A, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry.
- 5. Take STENCIL 2/B and place adjacent to painted STENCIL 1/A, exactly matching the Alignment Circles. Mark the Alignment Squares with chalk. Paint STENCIL 2/B, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry.
- 6. Take STENCIL 2/B and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 2/B adjacent to painted STENCIL 2/B exactly matching the Alignment Squares. Mark the Alignment Circles with chalk. Paint STENCIL 2/B, remove, lay on tarp and dry.. Allow paint to dry.
- Take STENCIL 1/A and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 1/A adjacent to painted STENCIL 2/B exactly matching the Alignment Circles. Mark the Alignment Rectangles with chalk. Paint STENCIL 1/A, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry.
- 8. Take STENCIL 1/A and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 1/A adjacent to painted STENCIL 1/A exactly matching the Alignment Rectangles. Mark the Alignment Circles with chalk. Paint STENCIL 1/A, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry.
- Take STENCIL 2/B and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 2/B adjacent to painted STENCIL 1/A exactly matching the Alignment Circles. Mark the Alignment Squares with chalk. Paint STENCIL 2/B, remove, lay on tarp and dry.. Allow paint to dry.
- 10. Take STENCIL 2/B and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 2/B adjacent to painted STENCIL 2/B exactly matching the Alignment Rectangles. Mark the Alignment Circles with chalk. Paint STENCIL 2/B, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry. Put STENCIL 2/B on tarp.
- 11. Take STENCIL 1/A and flip over, making sure the surfaces are completely dry. Position STENCIL 1/A between the starting painted STENCIL 1/A and painted STENCIL 2/B, exactly matching the Alignment Circles and Alignment Squares. Paint STENCIL 1/A, remove, lay on tarp and dry. Allow paint to dry.



#### SEQUENCE FOR LAYING OUT STENCILS





- 12. Touch-up the gaps between along the Circle Outline with paint, repeating 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness.
- 13. Paint the field (inside) of the circle in any color you prefer. Use 9" paint rollers and as you approach the edges of the outlines, tip the roller, applying pressure to the end and carefully and slowly paint as close to the edge of the lines as possible. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.
- 14. Allow all paint to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before use.

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### CATERPILLAR HOPSCOTCH

Product Number: 11-2W-025

**SIZE:** approximately 15 feet long x 4 feet wide **ESTIMATED PAINT TIME:** approximately 1 - 2 people for 1 - 2 hours.

**FIRST READ:** Completely read "General Instructions". Prepare surfaces as recommended before painting.

1. Place STENCIL A in desired location. Paint STENCIL A and let paint dry. Using chalk, mark the alignment holes on each side of the bottom of the body.



2. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, and remove STENCIL A. Align STENCIL B using the alignment holes chalked out. And paint STENCIL B.





3. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application, and remove STENCIL B. It should look like this:



4. After completely drying, place and align the face and numbered cutouts within spaces starting with "1" at the left side of the tail end of the caterpillar as shown below. Paint as desired with thin brush. Let dry. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.





5. Only completely dry, remove face and numbered cut outs. The stencil should look as follows:



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
