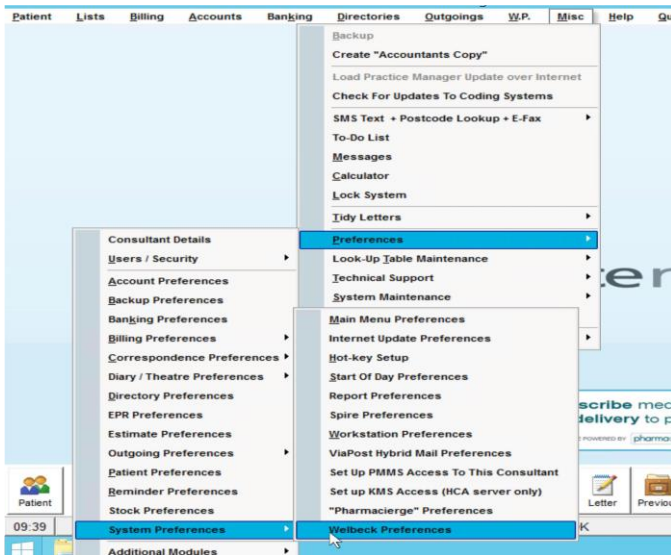
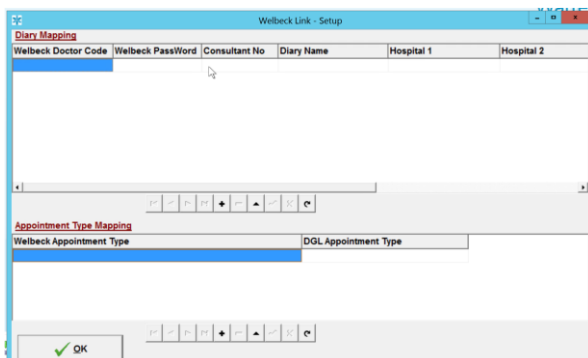


Enabling the Compucare 8 – DGL interface



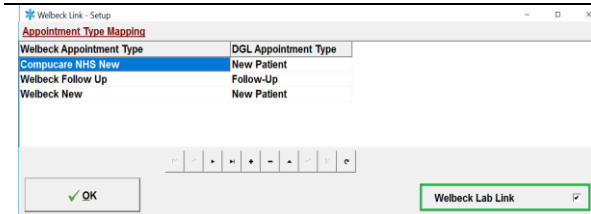
1. Open DGL practice Manager and access the Welbeck preferences via the Misc menu as shown:
 - a. Misc > Preferences > System Preferences > Welbeck Preferences

Note: If the menu item is not available, the interface has not been enabled by DGL support. Please contact OneWelbeck IT to request this.

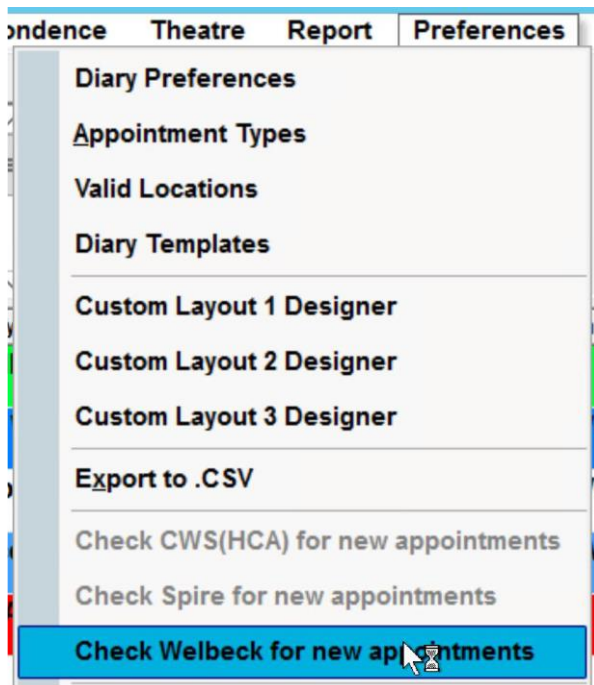


2. In the top half of the box, input the consultant code and password (provided by OneWelbeck) and choose the target consultant, DGL diary and DGL Hospital(s) to be synced with OneWelbeck.
 - a. At least one DGL Hospital must be selected, you can pick up to 3.
 - b. Only appointments created at the hospital(s) specified here will be transferred to OneWelbeck.
 - c. **Note:** Please enter "OneWelbeck" (No space and capital O and W) in the Diary Name box.
3. In the bottom half of the box, Appointment Types can be mapped from incoming Welbeck appointment types to DGL appointment types to avoid importing the Welbeck appointment types into DGL. The OneWelbeck Appointment types are:
 - a. New Patient Consultation
 - b. New Consultation
 - c. Follow Up
 - d. Annual

4. These can be mapped to the DGL appointment types for the currently logged on consultant, which are available in the picklist under 'DGL Appointment Type'.



5. Also in the bottom half of the box, towards the right is a Welbeck Lab Link option, with a box to next to it. This will enable or disable whether reports and results will come to you via CompuCare.



6. The interface is now enabled, though a restart of your DGL software may be required.
