V. Responsibilities & Time Commitment

Participation in SIMA's Board of Directors at an international level provides a unique opportunity for an individual to make a significant contribution to the snow & ice management industry. Participation also carries with it certain time commitments, both of your personal time and time away from your office. To gauge the time and financial commitments, the following information should be helpful:

- Directors serve (1) three-year term with possible election to a 2nd three-year term.
- Board participation requires three in-person meetings each fiscal year (FY runs January 1 – December 31) with a travel stipend of \$1,000 per meeting. Any additional costs are the responsibility of the board member. One of these meetings will always occur at the Snow & Ice Symposium.
- Generally, the SIMA board meets quarterly via conference call for one hour.
- Participation on at least one standing board committee is required. These committees typically meet via conference call every other month for 1 hour.
