We will enter God's presence together daily, praying for the power of the Holy Spirit to sweep through our circumstances, giving us the breakthroughs that we need in our lives and the life of our church! We believe that this season-the next 21 days--will be a defining moment in our lives, in our relationships with God, as well as the life of Bethlehem Church!

WHY FAST?

Simply put, biblical fasting is a spiritual discipline with the purpose of drawing nearer to God. The goal of fasting is to eliminate distractions, aligning ourselves with God and praying according to His will. Fasting gives us spiritual eyes to see so that we may pray in order to accomplish His purposes and not our own. It is like a spiritual reboot for our soul, renewing and resetting us from the inside out. It also helps us to celebrate the goodness and mercy of God by shifting our focus on Him and away from ourselves, preparing our hearts for all the good things God wants to do and bring into our lives. Remember, your personal fast should present a level of challenge to you, but it is very important to know your body, your options, and, most importantly, to seek God in prayer and follow what the Holy Spirit is leading you to do.

We see fasting practiced all throughout scripture.

EVEN JESUS FASTED!

HOW DO WE CLOTHE OURSELVES WITH STRENGTH? WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO CLOTHE OURSELVES WITH STRENGTH

MUCH LIKE A WARRIOR MUST PUT ON ARMOR BEFORE GOING INTO A PHYSICAL BATTLE, WE MUST PUT ON SPIRITUAL ARMOR BEFORE HEADING INTO OUR OWN "BATTLES."

Scripture tells us to clothe ourselves with strength: "Wake up, wake up, O Zion! Clothe yourself with strength. Put on your beautiful clothes, O holy city of Jerusalem, for unclean and godless people will enter your gates no longer. Rise from the dust, O Jerusalem. Sit in a place of honor. Remove the chains of slavery from your neck, O captive daughter of Zion" (Isaiah 52:1-2).

PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by PRAYER AND SUPPLICATION WITHTHANKSGIVING

let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.



COMPLETE FAST

In this type of fast, you drink only liquids, typically water and/or light juices as an option.

SELECTIVE FAST

This type of fast involves removing certain foods from your diet. One example of a selective fast is the Daniel Fast, during which you remove meat, sweets, and bread from your diet and consume water and juice for fluids and fruits and vegetables for food.

PARTIAL FAST

This fast involves abstaining from entire meals for a designated amount of time. One example of this fast is called the "Jewish Fast" which is a full-day fast that begins with sunset in the evening and continues until sunset the next day. A minor fast day begins with the dawn and concludes at darkness. This can either correlate to specific times of the day, such as 6:00 am to 3:00 pm, or from sunup to sundown.

SOUL FAST

This fast is a great option if you do not have much experience fasting food, have health issues that prevent you from fasting food, or if you wish to refocus certain areas of your life that are out of balance. For example, you might choose to stop using social media or watching television for the duration of the fast and then carefully bring that element back into your life in healthy doses at the conclusion of the fast. Set **LIMITS** on your screen time and/or your media use. You might **GIVE UP** certain movies and television entirely or just at certain times of the day or week. You could **SAY NO** screen time after a certain time. Or **DELETE** the social media app you use the most on your phone. Then, use that **TIME** you would have otherwise spent on a screen in **PRAYER** and **STUDYING** the Word.

OTHER EXAMPLES INCLUDE:



MATTHEW 17:20

1 JOHN 5:14-15

AND THIS IS THE CONFIDENCE THAT WE HAVE TOWARD HIM, THAT IF WE

ASK ANYTHING ACCORDING TO HIS WILL

HE HEARS US. 15 A ND IF WE KNOW THAT HE HEARS US IN WHATEVER WE ASK, WE KNOW THAT WE HAVE THE REQUESTS THAT WE HAVE ASKED OF HIM.

BUT WHEN YOU PRAY, GO INTO YOUR ROOM AND SHUT THE DOOR AND

PRAY TO YOUR FATHER WHO IS IN SECRET.

AND YOUR FATHER WHO SEES IN SECRET WILL REWARD YOU.



THERE IS NO SPECIFIC FORMULA ON HOW TO TALK TO GOD, BUT PRAYING SCRIPTURE, GOD'S WORDS, BACK TO HIM IN DIFFERENT WAYS CAN HELP US FIND DEEPER PURPOSE AND CONNECTION TO HIM THROUGH OUR PRAYER TIME. THE GOAL OF USING THIS GUIDE IS NOT TO ADD PRESSURE OR OVERWHELM YOU, BUT TO HELP YOU GET COMFORTABLE TALKING TO GOD, AND FOR YOUR PRAYER LIFE TO BECOME MORE NATURAL, EFFECTIVE, AND ENJOYABLE.

USE THE PRAYER GUIDE AS A TOOL TO PRAY INTENTIONALLY. IF YOUR MIND WANDERS, USE THE MODEL TO RESTORE YOUR FOCUS. FEEL FREE TO ADD YOUR OWN PERSONAL PRAYERS, AS WELL. AS YOU PRAY, BE SURE TO TAKE TIME TO LISTEN. WRITE WHAT GOD MAY BE SPEAKING TO YOU IN THE JOURNAL SPACE PROVIDED. TO MAKE YOUR PRAYER TIME EVEN MORE MEANINGFUL, YOU CAN WRITE NOTES OR PRAYER REQUESTS AND PLAY WORSHIP MUSIC. THE MOST IMPORTANT STEP IS COMMITTING TO REGULARLY ENTERING GOD'S PRESENCE THROUGH PRAYER.

THE GUIDE WAS WRITTEN TO HELP YOU FIND A NEW LEVEL OF PURPOSE, EFFECTIVENESS, AND ENJOYMENT IN YOUR PRAYER LIFE. WHILE PRAYER DOES TAKE COMMITMENT AND CAN REQUIRE DISCIPLINE TO DEVELOP INTO A DAILY HABIT, WE ALSO WANT TO REMEMBER THAT IT'S A "GET TO," NOT A "GOT TO." IT'S A PRIVILEGE TO BE ABLE TO COME TO GOD IN PRAYER.





Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you doubleminded.



Pray for intimacy with God to grow over the next 21 days. Pray – God, draw me for intimacy with God to grow over the next 21 days. God, draw me into a deeper relationship with you and give me a greater understanding of your love. God help me to love you with my whole heart. Empower me through your Holy Spirit to love you with my whole heart and obey you joyfully.





SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

1 John 4:10-11

In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.



Pray for your love for others to deepen. Pray for stronger relationships with those closest to you. Pray specifically for spouse, children, family members, and coworkers.





Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!



Pray for repentance of sin. Pray - Search me and know my heart, God. Point out anything in me that offers you. God is faithful and just to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Eph. 6:19-20

...and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel.



Pray for our Pastors and spiritual leaders. Pray that God would help them stay faithful to the work before them and His call on their lives. Pray for their health, protection, and for their families. Pray for their hearts to remain pure and devoted to God, serving faithfully in prayer and study of God's Word. **§**5



Matthew 9:37-38 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."



Pray for our church, for the Holy Spirit to breathe new life, ideas, and creativity, by preaching the gospel in all that we do, and being good stewards of the resources we have been given. Pray that our church would be healthy and growing and for the harvest of workers to be abundant so that more people will come to know Jesus.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

1 Timothy 2:1-2 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Numbers 6:22-27

The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall bless the people of Israel: you shall say to them, 'The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.' So shall they put my name upon the people of Israel, and I will bless them."



Pray for generations after us our children and their children to follow in the footsteps of Jesus and to leave this world in a better place than they inherited it! That our faith would leave an impact long after we are gone.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Proverbs 3:9-10

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.



Pray to be faithful with our finances and all the resources we have been given. Pray that we would give God our first fruits in all that we do.





2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.



Pray for unsaved loved ones. God, today I pray for (____). They are in need of a new heart, the kind of heart only You can give. For Your Word tells us the human heart is sick and wicked, needing to be changed. Please replace their heart of stone with a humble heart, a clean heart, a pure heart, a believing heart. The kind of heart that can accept God and the truth of the gospel. Above all, may they have a repentant heart, Lord. In Jesus' saving name, I pray, Amen.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Matthew 6:9-10

Pray for God to speak to us through His word. Pray for revelation, deeper understanding, and insight and a willingness to obey what we hear.





SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

James 1:22-25

But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.



Pray that we would obey what God tells us. Be doers of His word, not hearers only.





Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.



Pray that we would fulfill the purposes for which we were created.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE John 3:30

He must increase, but I must decrease.



Pray that we would decrease and that Christ would increase in us. Less of me, more of you, God.





Galatians 5:1 For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.



For God to heal wounds from our past to set us free for our future.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, selfcontrol; against such things there is no law.



Pray for the fruit of the spirit to be evident in our lives. Pray that our lives would be filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.





2 Chronicles 7:14

For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. Pray that our nation would turn and seek Jesus in humility and that God would bringing healing to our nation.
