Fasting helps us eliminate distractions, it helps us depend on God and we believe Bethlehem Kids are up for the church-wide challenge. Follow along through these pages, and together, let's see what God has in store for you, your family, and our church.

WHY FAST?

Simply put, biblical fasting is a spiritual discipline that helps you draw near to God. The goal of fasting is to get rid of distractions and build our relationship with God. Fasting gives us eyes to see how God sees, so that we may pray to achieve what God wants us to, not what we want to. Fasting also helps us to celebrate God's goodness, His grace, and mercy, but changing our focus to God instead of ourselves. It prepares our hearts for all the good things God wants to do and bring to our lives. Remember, your personal fast should be a challenge to you, not what someone else is doing or wants to do. Most importantly pray with your parents and let the Holy Spirit lead you on what to do.

We see fasting practiced all throughout scripture.

HOW DO WE CLOTHE

MUCH LIKE A WARRIOR MUST PUT ON ARMOR BEFORE GOING INTO A PHYSICAL BATTLE, WE MUST PUT ON SPIRITUAL ARMOR BEFORE HEADING INTO OUR OWN "BATTLES."

Scripture tells us to clothe ourselves with strength: "Wake up, wake up, O Zion! Clothe yourself with strength. Put on your beautiful clothes, O holy city of Jerusalem, for unclean and godless people will enter your gates no longer. Rise from the dust, O Jerusalem. Sit in a place of honor. Remove the chains of slavery from your neck, O captive daughter of Zion" (Isaiah 521-2)

PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by

PRAYER AND SUPPLICATION WITH THANKSGIVING

let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.



COMPLETE FAST

In this type of fast, you would give up something completely for 21 days.

SELECTIVE FAST

This type of fast involves removing certain things, for example, you might want to fast from a video game but not all of your video games. Or maybe it's fasting from a certain tv show you love, but not all tv. It could be that you remove sweets from your diet or your favorite candy.

PARTIAL FAST

This type of fast would be giving up something during a certain time of the day.

OTHER EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

SACRIFICE

Sacrifice your sleep by getting up earlier or going to your room a little early at bedtime to spend time reading your Bible, doing a devotion, and praying.



GIVE

Give away some of your toys. Work on decluttering your room by donating a certain number of items per day.

HABIT

Has fighting with your sibling or talking back to your parents become a habit for you? Consider asking your parents to hold you accountable. When you want to fight or talk back, talk to God instead.

ALLOWANCE

Consider saving your allowance rather than spending it.

What if you chose a certain amount of time each day to be still before the Lord?



THERE IS NO SPECIFIC FORMULA ON HOW TO TALK TO GOD, BUT PRAYING SCRIPTURE, GOD'S WORDS, BACK TO HIM IN DIFFERENT WAYS CAN HELP US FIND DEEPER PURPOSE AND CONNECTION TO HIM THROUGH OUR PRAYER TIME. THE GOAL OF USING THIS GUIDE IS NOT TO ADD PRESSURE OR OVERWHELM YOU, BUT TO HELP YOU GET COMFORTABLE TALKING TO GOD, AND FOR YOUR PRAYER LIFE TO BECOME MORE NATURAL, EFFECTIVE, AND ENJOYABLE.

USE THE PRAYER GUIDE AS A TOOL TO PRAY INTENTIONALLY. IF YOUR MIND WANDERS, USE THE MODEL TO RESTORE YOUR FOCUS. FEEL FREE TO ADD YOUR OWN PERSONAL PRAYERS, AS WELL. AS YOU PRAY, BE SURE TO TAKE TIME TO LISTEN. WRITE WHAT GOD MAY BE SPEAKING TO YOU IN THE JOURNAL SPACE PROVIDED. TO MAKE YOUR PRAYER TIME EVEN MORE MEANINGFUL, YOU CAN WRITE NOTES OR PRAYER REQUESTS AND PLAY WORSHIP MUSIC. THE MOST IMPORTANT STEP IS COMMITTING TO REGULARLY ENTERING GOD'S PRESENCE THROUGH PRAYER.

THE GUIDE WAS WRITTEN TO HELP YOU FIND A NEW LEVEL OF PURPOSE, EFFECTIVENESS, AND ENJOYMENT IN YOUR PRAYER LIFE. WHILE PRAYER DOES TAKE COMMITMENT AND CAN REQUIRE DISCIPLINE TO DEVELOP INTO A DAILY HABIT, WE ALSO WANT TO REMEMBER THAT IT'S A "GET TO," NOT A "GOT TO." IT'S A PRIVILEGE TO BE ABLE TO COME TO GOD IN PRAYER.



James 4:8

Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you doubleminded.





Pray for your relationship with God, to grow over the next 21 days. God give me a greater understanding of your love. God, help me to love you with my whole heart.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

1 John 4:10-11

In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.



Pray for your love for others to deepen. Pray for stronger relationships with those closest to you. Pray specifically for parents, siblings, grandparents, teachers, friends, and community.







Psalm 139:23-24

Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!



Pray for repentance of sin. Search me and know me God.

Repent: to turn from sin and change going forward.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Eph. 6:19-20

...and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel.





Pray for our Pastors and spiritual leaders. Pray that God would help them stay faithful to the work before them and His call on their lives. Pray for their health, protection, and for their families. Pray for their hearts to remain pure and devoted to God, serving faithfully in prayer and study of God's Word.





Matthew 9:37-38

Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."





Pray for Bethlehem Church, for people to know Jesus and grow in their relationship with God.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

1 Timothy 2:1-2

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.



Pray for our leaders in government. God, give them strength and wisdom and guide all their decisions. Surround them with people who will speak godly wisdom and counsel into their lives. Bring to them people of high moral character and spiritual maturity.







Acts 4:29-30

And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness, while you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus.



Pray for personal boldness to tell others about Him. Pray that our faith would increase and our fear of what others think would decrease.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Ephesians 5:6-7

Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. Therefore do not become partners with them.



Pray to be world changers, and that our communities would be better because we are here. God, help us make a lasting impact, being light in a dark world, giving hope to others around us.







Numbers 6:22-27

The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall bless the people of Israel: you shall say to them, 'The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.' So shall they put my name upon the people of Israel, and I will bless them."



Pray for kids younger than you to know Jesus and follow in his footsteps.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Proverbs 3:9-10

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.



Pray to be faithful with the money God has given you.

Give God your first fruits.







2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.





Pray for unsaved loved ones. God, today I pray for (____). They are in need of a new heart, the kind of heart only You can give. For Your Word tells us the human heart is sick and wicked, needing to be changed. Please replace their heart of stone with a humble heart, a clean heart, a pure heart, a believing heart. The kind of heart that can accept God and the truth of the gospel. Above all, may they have a repentant heart, Lord. In Jesus' saving name, I pray, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Matthew 6.9-10

Pray then like this:
'Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your
name. Your kingdom
come, your will be
done, on earth as it is
in heaven.



Pray for God's Kingdom to come, on earth as it is in Heaven. Pray that we would be Kingdom-minded, bringing what's up there down here!





John 17:21

...that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.



Pray for unity within the body of Christ. Pray that we are one, just as Jesus and the Father are one.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Mark 11:24-25

Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.



Pray for God to help you with bitterness and any unwillingness to forgive.





Ephesians 1:18

...having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints...



Pray for God to speak to us through His Word. For a better understanding of Scripture.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

James 1:22-25

But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.



Pray that we would obey what God tells us. Be doers of His word, not hearers only.





Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.





Pray that we would fulfill the purposes for which we were created.



SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

John 3:30

He must increase, but I must decrease.



Pray that we would decrease and that Christ would increase in us. Less of me, more of you, God.







Galatians 5:1

For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.



For God to heal wounds from our past to set us free for our future.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, selfcontrol; against such things there is no law.



Pray for the fruit of the spirit to be evident in our lives. Pray that our lives would be filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.





2 Chronicles 7:14

For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end.



Pray that our nation would turn and seek Jesus in humility and that God would bring healing to our nation.







A FINAL WORD:

Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. Therefore, put on

EVERYPIECE OF GOD'S ARMOR

so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the

BELT OF TRUTH

and the

BODY ARMOR

of God's righteousness.

FOR SHOES.

put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. In addition to all of these, hold up the

SHIELD OF FAITH

to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. Put on

SALVATION AS YOUR HELMET,

and take the

SWORD OF THE SPIRIT,

which is the word of God. Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere.
