What is it?

Who is Identity Service Integration for?

Any organisation that has Jamf Pro or datajar.mobi and requires or has the following:

- Technical staff who are inexperienced or unfamiliar with Apple's services and would like help and support to leverage all available capabilities.
- An administrator or centralised IT team who will be designing and building your organisation's device management service.
- A need to integrate cloud-based authentication/authorisation services for their macOS or iOS devices
- A need to implement MFA into login workflows for macOS

How does it work?

This is a remote, one-day professional services engagement delivered by one of our senior systems engineers, which will focus on understanding your infrastructure and integrating key identity technologies into your environment.

The focus of the engagement could range from a consultancy to review or update existing workflows, to design and implementation of additional functionality and security within your environment.

Requirements:

- Access to a suitable Jamf Pro or datajar.mobi environment
- At least one employee within the organisation with appropriate access (passwords) to the relevant systems should be present or available for the entire process
- Information to hand with regards to the current environment configurations such as Kerberos Realm, Active Directory security groups and file shares
- One macOS device that can be erased for building packages and testing. This device should only have a clean macOS installed, no additional software installed or settings configured
